



2.3 電源の切り方について

1. 電源の切り方

Windows のシャットダウン機能を使用することで、安全に電源を切る事が出来ます。

方法1:

- 1. キーボードの[Ctrl]+[Alt]+[Delete]キーを同時に押します。
- 2. 表示された画面右下に表示されるシャットダウンを選択してください。シャットダウンが完了すると自動的に電源が OFF になります。

方法 2:装置前面のプッシュ式電源スイッチを押すことで、シャットダウンが実行され、自動的に電源が OFF になります。



・シャットダウンを正常に完了させる為に、装置前面のプッシュ式電源スイッチは長押し(約3秒以上)しないで下さい。

2. 電源の再投入

方法1:装置背面の電源スイッチを一旦 OFF にし、再度 ON にすることで電源の再投入ができます。

方法 2: 装置背面の電源スイッチが ON の場合、装置前面のプッシュ式電源スイッチを押すことで電源の再投入ができます。




- ・電源スイッチ OFF 後に再投入する場合は、5 秒以上の時間をおいてから行ってください。
- ・シャットダウンプロセスを実行後、電源スイッチを OFF にしてください。 ファイル装置にアクセスしている状態(装置全面の HDD ランプ点灯中) や、Windows が起動しアプリケーションが 実行できる状態になる前に電源を切るとファイル装置の内容に致命的な損傷を与える恐れがあります。

3. 設置と点検



注意

3.1 安全にご使用いただくために


3.2 付属の金具の付け方

3.2.1 取り付け金具(設置)


付属の取り付け金具を使用することによって、本体を固定して設置することが出来ます。

- (1) OS をシャットダウンし、本体背面の電源スイッチを OFF にします。
- (2) 本体に接続されているケーブル類はすべて外します。
- (3) 本体横面にある下図矢印のネジ穴に取り付け金具を添付ネジでしっかりと固定します。

(4) 取り付け金具の下図矢印の設置用穴を利用して本体を固定します。


本体を固定しないと、誤って落下して装置を壊す事があります。取り付け金具を利用して設置してください。取り付け金具を本体に取り付ける際に添付ネジ以外のネジを使用される場合は、添付ネジと同じ M3×8mm 組みネジを使用してください。長すぎるネジは装置内部を破壊するおそれがあります。

3.2.2 取り付け金具(連結)

- (1) OS をシャットダウンし、本体の主電源スイッチを OFF にします。
- (2) 本体に接続されているケーブル類はすべて外します。
- (3) 連結する本体を上下段に並べます。
- (4) 本体横面にある下図矢印のネジ穴に取り付け金具を添付ネジでしっかりと固定します。


<上段本体のネジ穴位置>




<下段本体のネジ穴位置>


連結をする場合は重量が増え、落下や怪我の恐れがあるため、水平設置時のみとし、下段は取り付け金具にて床面へしっかり固定してください。

水平設置時の最大連結数は5台までとなります。

水平設置時以外は、連結して使用することは出来ません。

3.3 設置方法

- 本体を固定せずに使用すると、移動や落下によって、本体が破損したり、人が怪我をする恐れがあります。 本体を設置する場合は、添付の取り付け金具等を使用して固定してください。
- 装置の設置に当たっては前面と背面に空間を設けてください。特に前面の排気ファン、背面の吸気口を塞がないようにしてください。



3.4 電源の配線

3.5 日常点検

3.6 データの保存

フラッシュファイル装置(SSD)は、ハードディスク(HDD)と比べて機構部がなく、非常に信頼性の高いデバイスですが、アクセス中の電源 OFF や故障により大切なプログラム、データファイルなどを失う恐れがあります。

SSD は SATA 接続となっており、SATA to USB 変換ケーブル等を使い、パソコンからファイルアクセスすることができます。また、LAN によるネットワーク共有機能を利用してファイルアクセスすることも可能です。

保守用の SSD ご購入を推奨します

何らかの原因で SSD 内部のファイルが壊れた場合、アプリケーションプログラム等は復旧可能ですが、システム領域等に問題があった場合は、弊社工場での再書込みや SSD の交換が必要です。復旧時間を短縮する為に、保守用として予備のシステム用 SSD のご購入をお勧めします。



4.1.1 吸気口·排気口

特に CPU、電源回路、DIDO 回路の発熱量は大きいので、ファンが止まっていないことを確認してください。






TRIGOUTx 端子の出力回路(オープンコレクタ出力)
